Our son Matthew is a 9 year old boy who has Cerebral Palsy and uses a wheelchair. His disability is challenging; but his ability to learn, play and grow is not unlike any other little boy. He enjoys school and his playmates; he hums a happy tune while in the family van; and he offers us a great big smile when we go outside to play.

We want to make sure that Matthew is always able to get out and enjoy those little things that brighten his day but creating the ability to offer simple pleasures comes with a large price tag. Matthew is growing and it has become increasingly difficult to lift him in and out of our van. We looked into modifying the van to make it accessible and found the cost was shockingly expensive – over \$10,000!
